ALE has been orginised annually since 2011. Not even the pandemic could stop the dedicated agile folks to organise and attend it.

AMONG THE BIG ONES ALE attracts over 250 agilists from around Europe

and from overseas every year. This makes ALE one of the largest agile events on the continent.

The Agile Lean Europe (ALE) network is an open and evolving network of people (not businesses), with links to local communities and institutes. To this date the community has 6,263 members.

ALE is organised around enthusiastic people with diverse perspectives across borders. This diversity allows stunning results to emerge during the event.

Between 28th and 30th August in 2024 a team of Hungarian agilists brings ALE to Budapest for the first time. Each year cities across Europe compete to host ALE just like for the Olympic Games. This time Budapest won!



HOW DOES IT HAPPEN

ALE has been different from a regular conference since its conception. The first ALE in Berlin 2011 used the unconference format which proved to be very successful and has not been changed since then.



OPEN SPACE TECHNOLOGY

Open Space Technology makes it possible to include everybody in constructing the agenda of the day. This ensures that the agenda contains items that are important to the attendees. Having cocreated the schedule of the day and being free to follow their curiosity and passion, people will take action to create the best experience for themselves.

Beside the daily conference program numerous networking activities are essential parts of ALE. Among the most popular events is the "Dinner with strangers" that serves to enrich the spirit of ALE via forming new connections year after year.


